

### SANTA CRUZ- A CORUÑA - CAMBRE


Early in the morning we will enjoy an outdoor activity in a unique landscape with panoramic views of the city of A Coruña. Afterwards we will have breakfast and leave to A Coruña to visit the Punta Herminia Natural Park. An authentic open-air museum on the banks of the Ria de A Coruña that ends up merging with the Atlantic waters. Here we will cross a door to experience the rite of passage of the Hero's Journey until we reach the Compass Rose with its representation of the 8 Celtic nations and finish with the history of the Tower of Hercules, the oldest operating lighthouse in the world (Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO since 2009) and its previous presence as Torre de Breogán. At this point we will stop to immerse ourselves in the myth and legend of the city of Brigantia, origin of current Coruña.

Next, we will approach Plaza María Pita, the nerve center of the historic center of the city, where we will do a brief review of this heroine and her importance for A Coruña before having lunch in the area.

After lunch and some free time to enjoy the Atlantic Balcony, we will proceed to move to the municipality of Cambre, an important stop on the English Way. There we will discover a relic of the Order of the Temple.

Return to the hotel and end of the day.

















## COIRÓS- CASTRO DE REI - LUGO

After breakfast and with our luggage ready, we proceed to check-out to continue towards Coirós, a town located 22km from A Coruña, to discover a Sacred Rock Sanctuary from the Bronze Age dedicated to Fertility. After living this sacred space of the ancestors originating from this land, and sharing an experience in the place with the help of a shaman and heir of ancient wisdom and knowledge, we will continue towards Castro de Rei to contemplate and walk through one of the best preserved Celtic Castros in the Province of Lugo. Declared an Asset of Cultural Interest, in this imposing enclosure we will connect with the way of life and understanding the forces of nature of its inhabitants and with the druidic wisdom and knowledge that has survived until this day.

From here, we will go to the city of Lugo where we will eat in a traditional inn in front of the Roman Walls.

Free afternoon-night to enjoy a walk through this vibrant nature, walk along the Roman Walls or stay at the Lugo Spa, where we will stay, and delight in its mineral-medicinal hot springs. We will give you instructions so that you can enjoy it to the fullest based on what you decide.













#### SACRED FOREST OF LUGO

Today will be a different day, we will leave in the morning having breakfast and prepared with comfortable clothing and good footwear to enter the Sacred Forest of Lugo; a classroom of ancestral nature. An ancient cult sanctuary where stone, water, and the sun are the protagonists. A space full of magic that will inspire us to take a Forest Bath and be guided to the beat of our heart to connect with this place.

After lunchl, we will leave a space for rest. Later, we will be accompanied by one of the members of the Sacred Forest Association of Lugo, guardian of this wonderful place. Through the memories that remain active in the stone and in the water, he will guide us on a time-journey from Penas das Rodas to Pena da Moura. Both structures are part of a megalithic complex of great value, located in a straight line with a distance of approximately 2km and which are considered an astronomical complex and a solar calendar, where the alignment between its structures and the sunrise on the winter solstice and the sunset on the summer solstice occur.

Return to the hotel so that everyone can freely dine and/or rest according to their needs.















## LUGO - BÓVEDA DE MERA- FISTERRA

Prepared with our suitcases, we will approach the center of Lugo to cross its walls where our expert collaborator in pre-Christian Roman history will be waiting for us. We will walk hand in hand through this city of Lucus Augusti and at the end we will head towards Bóveda de Mera. There we will visit the Sanctuary of Santa Eulalia de Bóveda, an enclave of great archaeological and architectural value, related to pre-Christian cult activities and waters, which makes it unique in Western Europe, being declared a National Historic-Artistic Monument. in 1931. This Temple is dedicated to the goddess Cybele, goddess of nature and fertility, venerated in Rome as the Great Mother of the Gods.

After this visit we will move towards Fisterra stopping to have lunch in Melide, a stop on the Camino Primitivo where we will taste the flavors of traditional Galician cuisine. Upon arriving in Fisterra we proceed to check-in and rest for a while, until it is time to move to the port to enjoy the Ara Solis by boat. Upon returning to land we will have free time so that everyone can experience the End of the Earth as they like best.

**NOTE** - The boat trip is subject to weather conditions.

















### **MUXIA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA**

After breakfast and with our baggage, we will check out to proceed to a tour of the Costa de la Muerte and experience a vision of the Ocean in its purest and wildest state, the fiercest coastal strip in all of Europe.

On the way to Muxía we will make a brief stop at Cape Touriñán, a place that is actually the westernmost end of the Iberian Peninsula where the sun sets every sunset, marking the true end of the route of our King Star, the Sun. Wild place of majestic landscape beauty, where the 4 elements that give life (water, earth, sun and air) are present at their maximum expression.

After that, we will approach Muxía, where we will meet another of our expert collaborators, who will surprise us with his explanation about this stone monument open to the sea and its Barca Sanctuary. He will take us on a journey through time to show us its most ancient meaning that turned Muxía into a place of great importance for pilgrimage and for its first settlers. There we can feel the energy of the Abalar Stone, which according to tradition has the power to transmit fertility.

After this wonderful experience, we will go to lunch to enjoy the delicacies that these waters offer us and later we will continue to Santiago de Compostela, where we will stay and have the rest of the day free.














## SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

#### PRACTICAL INFORMATION

In summer, the mild climate predominates on the coast, it is hotter inland and sometimes it can rain, so we recommend to bring a raincoat and/or umbrella. Since there will be the possibility of swimming in the Lugo Spa, it is recommended to bring a swimsuit, hat and flip-flops. Comfortable shoes and clothing are also recommended for activities that will take place in nature.

For the day of the boat trip it is advisable to bring a windbreaker and something warm.

If any interested party has reduced mobility, they must inform us to see if we can cover their needs. Likewise, any type of food intolerance must be reported at the time of formalizing the reservation.
